HAIR DRESSING

The Hair Dressing Project empowers refugees and host communities in Uganda with hands-on training in plaiting and hair styling. By turning skill into income, it fosters self-reliance, boosts entrepreneurship, and strengthens community resilience—creating pathways to sustainable livelihoods.

Graduates of the program are empowered to start their own businesses, secure employment in salons, or offer mobile services—turning skill into opportunity.

MUSIC RECORDING STUDIO

The Community Music Recording Studio, under Mirror Group Network, provides a platform for local artists, youth, and community groups to showcase their musical talents.

The studio offers affordable, high-quality music recording and production services, along with training in music production.
